

CAMPBELL TOWN WATER TREATMENT PLANT – OPEN TO THE PUBLIC

Ben Lomond Water today opened the site of the \$5.2 million Campbell Town Water Treatment Plant to the communities it will service.

“We want to share progress of this significant project with the people who have waited for treated water for many years,” Mr Cash said

“While the plant isn’t finished, it is close and construction is on schedule for completion early next year.

“For our customers and the community in Ross and Campbell Town this is a way of us letting them know where the project is up to and also thanking them for their patience and support,” Mr Cash said.

Campbell Town and Ross have been under a boil water alert since February 2010 and Ben Lomond Water continues to provide access to clean water at the Campbell Town football ground and Ross fire station.

This is an exciting project for the Campbell Town and Ross communities and for Ben Lomond Water. We are currently working on projects to deliver treated water to a number of other towns in our region and we look forward to making announcements in the near future.
